#### 11. GENERAL BUSINESS

- 11.1 **Annual General Meeting (AGM).** The AGM will be held in conjunction with our next Monthly General Meeting, 8 March 2025. A Notice and Agenda will be issued shortly.
- 11.2 **Anzac Day.** Peter White advised the meeting that planning of the event is well underway and a number of key activities are already locked in. The President advised the meeting that Peter has been running the event for a number of years and will be standing down. ### 12. OTHER BUSINESS.

- 12.1 **Credit Card Payment Capability.** The Secretary advised that the Committee considered options for an Electronic Funds Point of Sale (EFTPOS) capability to enable members to use credits cards. The preferred solution is a Tyro 'tap & go' device and proceeding with a trial. Tyro provides devices at no cost to NFP organisations with no fees or lock in contracts and discounted merchant fee of 1.2%.
- 12.2 **Feedback on Christmas Party 2024.** While the event was a success the support for it was less than desirable. Attendance was disappointing and we struggled to make the event worthwhile. Feedback of members was sought but nothing offered at the meeting. If we are run the event again this year, members are urged to complete acceptance before the published end date, as Mounties require 14 days' notice on the numbers attending.
